ALL **ANALOG** AND **ISDN** TELEPHONE LINES WILL BE DEACTIVATED IN SWITZERLAND BY THE END OF 2017. TELECOM USERS IN SWITZERLAND MUST BEGIN PREPARATIONS NOW.

The providers of Switzerland's telecommunications backbone have announced the elimination of all traditional telephone landlines by the end of 2017, changing to an entirely digital system called Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP).

PhoneWorld already has the new technology in place to convert your landlines to VoIP during 2016-2017. The new technology also allows PhoneWorld customers to make calls on their mobile phones via an IP call application, with savings up to 70%.

The new technology may require an update of your current PBX/phone installation or an additional device to make it VoIP-compatible.

Residential customers may contact us for a no-cost installation of **Call & Surf**, a ULL technology (unbundling local loop) compatible with future systems.
